Old Business:

- Fence cap on all the other CTP fields and eventually Cape Horn
 - o Marty Gordon to take measurements
- Rock screening:
 - o Luke Woodward has a contractor that is willing to donate their time and equipment to screen all the fields
 - o Start at Manchester ES, then the small field at Cape Horn and last would be CTP fields after football is done
- Check with schools to see if we can work on the fields during summer school
- Sign up sheet for dragging fields during the off season
 - o Main focus is Manchester ES
- Equipment – an email was sent to all coaches asking for equipment to be returned to CTP A Field
 - o Inventory will be done this summer
- 4 wheeler was sold
- Moved the 3 wheeler to CTP from Cape Horn
- Moved the tractor from Manchester ES to Cape Horn
- Going to take the golf cart to be tuned up

New Business:

- Spring season went well
 - o Manchester ES desperately needs to have their fields redone and regularly maintained
- 2022 MBA will be reinstating the coaches clinics before the season starts
- 7/8 was all in house
 - o Look into modifying the rules for 2022
- 9/10 partnered with Westminster/Winfield
 - o Westminster/Winfield were very happy with the season
- 11/12 partnered with Westminster/Winfield
 - o Both teams made it far in the playoffs and one made it to the Championship
- Travel – 11U and 14U went far in the MABA Tourney
 - o Looking to expand into other ages for 2022
- Fall Ball – looking to get registration open next week
 - o Potential partnership with Westminster/Winfield
 - o Potential Partnership with Hampstead
 - o Ages are expected to be 7-9 and 10-12
 - o All kid pitch is preferred
 - o There was some interest for ages younger than 7 and it was recommended that we try to put together some clinics
- Follow up with Trevis Tyree about water tanks for the fields at CTP and Cape Horn, he is willing to donate the water
- All Kids Play – Jeffrey Howard to follow up with Tiff Kallenberger to report the balance in that fund
 - o This is a program that people donate money to so underprivileged kids can participate
- Fundraising
 - o Gift Card donations to do giveaways for social media likes/shares
 - o Matt Kallenberger wants to start an annual gold outing
 - Going to meet with some local golf courses this summer to try and plan something for Summer 2022
 - o Hit-a-thon is the biggest fundraiser to date
 - o Look into setting up a Dunk Tank and/or Radar Gun at Hampstead Carnival
